

# Kugluktuk Liquor Plebiscite 2018

## Advance Vote – October 15 Regular Voting Day – October 22

A liquor plebiscite will be held in Kugluktuk.

Regular Voting Day will take place on October 22 from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m. at the Community Hall.

You are eligible to vote at this plebiscite if you:

- ✓ are a Canadian Citizen
- ✓ will be at least 19 years old by October 22
- ✓ will have been a resident of Kugluktuk for 12 months on October 22

The Advance Vote for the liquor plebiscite will take place on October 15 at the Kugluktuk Heritage and Visitors' centre from 10 a.m. to 7 p.m.

If you are unable to vote on either October 15 or 22 you can vote by proxy.

Proxy forms are available from Elections Nunavut.

### Plebiscite Ballot

Are you in favour of ending the current system of liquor restriction in Kugluktuk and having an unrestricted system where only the general liquor laws of Nunavut apply?

## Explanation of the Question

If 60% or more of the votes cast are "YES":

1. The current system of liquor restriction in Kugluktuk will be abolished, and the *Kugluktuk Liquor Restriction Regulations*, registered as regulation numbered R-027-2007, and the *Declaration of Restricted Area (Kugluktuk)*, registered as regulation numbered R-026-2007, will be repealed.
2. The Kugluktuk Alcohol Education Committee, established under the *Kugluktuk Liquor Restriction Regulations*, will be dissolved.
3. There will be no restrictions on liquor in Kugluktuk, except for the general liquor laws that apply in Nunavut.

If more than 40% of the votes cast are "NO":

The current system of liquor restriction in Kugluktuk will continue, and the Kugluktuk Alcohol Education Committee will continue to exist.
