# Kugluktuk Liquor Plebiscite 2018

## What is a liquor plebiscite?

- ✓ Community members decide if they want to change the laws that control alcohol in their community.
- ✓ A secret ballot asks a question about community liquor laws.
- ✓ Eligible voters mark the secret ballot 'YES' or 'NO'.
- ✓ The laws change if 60% or more vote 'YES'.

## What do Kugluktuk liquor laws say right NOW?

- ✓ The community has a liquor restriction. A person has to request to purchase liquor through the Kugluktuk Alcohol Education Committee.

## Ballot Question

Are you in favour of ending the current system of liquor restriction in Kugluktuk and having an unrestricted system where only the general liquor laws of Nunavut apply?

YES     NO

- YES means you want the law to change.**
- NO means you want the law to stay the same.**

## Explanation of Question

**If 60% or more of the votes cast under the question are "YES":**

1. The current system of liquor restriction in Kugluktuk will be abolished, and the *Kugluktuk Liquor Restriction Regulations*, registered as regulation numbered R-007-2007, and the *Declaration of Restricted Area (Kugluktuk)*, registered as regulation numbered R-026-2007, will be repealed.
2. The Kugluktuk Alcohol Education Committee, established under the *Kugluktuk Liquor Restriction Regulations*, will be dissolved.
3. There will be no restrictions on liquor in Kugluktuk, except for the general liquor laws that apply in Nunavut.

**If more than 40% of the votes cast under the question are "NO":**

The current system of liquor restriction in Kugluktuk will continue to exist, and the Kugluktuk Alcohol Education Committee will continue to exist.
