

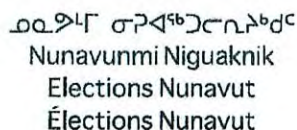

Appendix A

We are not able to determine if the candidate's Campaign Financial Return was prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Nunavut Elections Act and the accounting guidelines issued by Elections Nunavut for the following reasons:

1. We were not able to substantiate campaign expenditures of \$600 due to supporting documentation not being available for inspection.
2. We were not able to substantiate campaign contributions and expenditures due to the campaign account statement not being available for inspection.



