Report of Contributions from a Campaign Gathering

At a campaign gathering the financial agent or someone they appoint can collect financial contributions: anonymous and named contributions. The gathering may also provide goods and services contributions.

Anonymous contributions: MUST be \$100 or less. Contributors do not give their name. On the campaign financial return the financial agent reports anonymous contributions from a gathering as a total for that gathering.

Named contributions: Each contributor gives their name and address. Each contributor that gives more than \$100 MUST give their name and address. On the campaign financial return the financial agent reports each named contribution from a gathering the same way they report all other named contributions. Before the end of the post-election period the financial agent provides a tax receipt for each named contribution.

Goods and services: The gathering may have a sponsor that contributes goods and services. For example the sponsor may donate a room, pay for food and tea and coffee, or pay for music entertainment. Anything the sponsor donates or pays for, and does not get reimbursed, is a goods and services contribution. The financial agent records the sponsor's name and address, and the market value of their goods and services contribution. The financial agent does NOT give a tax receipt for any goods and services contribution. On the campaign financial return the financial agent reports goods and services contributions from a gathering the same way they report other goods and services contributions.

Neighbouring communities contest new Aivilik seat

Johnny Ningeongan seeks re-election in rejigged Aivilik

Although his constituency changed, Johnny Ningrongan says his priorities for re-election as a Nunavut MLA in the Kivalliq region have out

Ningrongan's community of Coral Harbour and its neighbour, Repulse Bay, are now together in the same constituency, Aivilik, for the Oct. 28 territorial election,

Thus marks a return to a similar arrangement before 1999, under the Northwest Territories.

"We're quite familiar with being under the same umbrelia," Ningeongan told Numanaa News, adding that both communities share simifar goals and long-term pro-

The MLA, who won his seat for the constituency of Nanulik in the 2008 election by just 32 votes, said he is taking nothing for given in this election.

Ningewagan's only opponent is Repulse Bay's Steve Mapsalak, Mapsalak did not return calls for an interview for this story.

Like Mingrongan, Mansalak has served as mayor of his community for several years, and one term as MLA for the neighbouring Akulliq constituency between 2004 and 2008.

The two communities are roughly equal in size, at about 900 residents each. Their high youth populations have made the need for new schools a priority.

"There's a new school

pending for Repulse Hay for 2014-2015, and a preliminary design plan for a new school ... Loral [Harbour]," Ningeongan sald, Rosh

Both are included in a five-year plan by the territorial coverament, he said, "and f for one will be a strong adviscate to make sure these things come through," he

Design plans for a new school for Coral Harbour, achieved during his mandate. has given Ningeongan *more assurance" that a new one can be built in the community over the next five years, he said.

On health care, the candidate has cited the need for a permanent mental health worker in Coral Harbour as

"We've never had one before, and we always rely on personnel coming in from the envernment to assist in that regard, " he said

Asked about the need for a full-time physician in Coral Harbour, which the commumay tacks, Kangcongan said this has been an ongoing issue.

"We rely heavily on going either to Rankin Inlet or Winnipeg for check-ups and for any medical reason," he said, adding that this is typical of small communities throughout the territory.

The best MLAs can do to improve service in small communities, he said, is to expand patient relations at regional offices in Rankin Inlet and Iqaluit, and "advocare for bester service" as larger health facilities in Win-

"Ilais is where I believe regular MLAs and ministers can make a difference," he

Meanwhile, Ningeongan pointed to the creation of a patient-relations office in ligabili this year as "one area down the road."

Born and raised in Coral harbour, Ningeongan, 63, worked for the hamles of Coral Harbour as a secretarymanager and as a public works foreman before his first election to the municipal council in the 1990s.

He served as hamler mayor for 10 years, until 2007, and won the Nanulik seat in the 2008 territorial

Ningeongan has served with several busit organizations, including the Kivalliq Association and touit Nunavus Tunneavik Inc., and said he prides himself as 'an advocate for small communi-

He and his opponent Steve Mapsalak *have known each other for a number of years now, as mayors, and in other areas as well," Nineconean said.

"I was running for MLA but then I got a job offer yesterday with Quiliq Energy so today I made up my mind to take the job and withdraw Purser said Oct. 10 on his Facebook timeline, which is open to the public.

Forter said he had fust landed a job as an assistant plant operator with the QEC and wishes to withdraw from the election.

But on Oct. 28, and in advance voies, Gjoa Haven voters will still see Andrew Porter's name on the ballot.

That's because declared candidates who change their minds and want their names removed from the ballot must deliver a signed letter to the local returning officer no later than 31 days before election day, at 5 p.m.

That letter must be signed by two other voters in the constituency, who must take

about 18 or 19 days prior to election day.

"If a candidate withdraws after the deadline, their name stays on the ballot - even if

Forter did not make his they send the RO a signed letwithdrawal decision until ter," the Elections Nunavut guide for candidates said.

Tony Akoak, Linda Hunter and George Sonny Porter are also contesting the Gloa Haven seat.




